TAIWAN -EUROPE CONNECTIVITY SCHOLARSHIP 2023

Ministry of Foreign Affairs Taiwan (MOFA) offers designated Taiwan-Europe Connectivity Scholarship to encourage international students to exchange or pursue their study at NTHU, as well as to promote bilateral exchanges and friendship between the peoples of Taiwan and Europe. This is a **non-renewable scholarship** opportunity.

I. THE AWARD PERIOD

Fall semester 2023 (from September 2023 - January 2024)

II. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Scholarship amount: A monthly scholarship of NTD20,000 and scholarship quotas are adjusted on a yearly base (depending on MOFA's budget). Every student can apply and receive the scholarship once. Recipients are responsible for all expenses during their stay in Taiwan. MOFA will not provide any other subsidies. (Scholarship payments start from the month when the recipient actually begins attending the university.)

III. ELIGIBILITY

- Holds a passport from United Kingdom, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Belgium, Slovak Republic, Finland, Sweden, Republic of Lithuania (MOFA will review and assign different countries every year)
- 2. Is a high school graduate or above with an excellent academic record, of good moral character and has no criminal record.
- 3. Is a prospective Exchange/ Degree/ Dual Degree student.
- 4. Is not a National of the Republic of China (Taiwan) or an overseas compatriot student.

IV. MISSION

- 1. The recipient is required to undertake at least 1 Chinese learning course (2 credits) each semester at NTHU Chinese Language Center and must meet the program's eligibility requirements.
- 2. The recipient is required to participate in a student-driven activity for the cultural interactions, such as being as a presenter for the session host or presenter for the info session for languages interactions, or other activities to facilitate the English-language interactions.
- 3. The recipient should submit a report of experience-sharing feedback in the format of graphic or audiovisual record.

VI. APPLICATION REQUIREMENT

Interested applicants should send the application including the following information drs@my.nthu.edu.tw before April 15, 2023.

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. A transcript of academic records (in English), issued by applicants' current university
- 3. A copy of passport

NOTE:

- 1. Recipients must not be currently receiving financial benefits from any Taiwan government agencies or educational institutions.
- 2. The termination and cancellation of a scholarship is based on regulations specified by NTHU. NTHU has the right to terminate or revoke a scholarship if the recipient's academic performance, moral character, or attendance record is not up to NTHU's standards.
