MOE Scholarship for Lecturers from South and Southeast Asia and all Countries in Africa

ELIGIBILITY

- Doctoral/Master degree-seeking applicants who are currently university lecturers or professors in Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, India, Malaysia, Singapore, Brunei, Myanmar, Cambodia, Laos, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bhutan and all countries in Africa.
- Applicants for an Elite Scholarship must apply directly to <u>National Tsing Hua</u>
 University for Admission for Fall Semester.

STUDY YEAR

Commencing from 2022 Fall Semester

DRUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

3 Years (In PH.D. program/ Review annually)

2 Years (In Master programs/ Review annually)

*To receive the two/ three-year continuous scholarship, the student's average score must achieve a minimum GPA of 3.4 in his/her previous academic year.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

NTD 300,000 per year*

*The scholarship doesn't include tuition waiver. Students will need to pay tuition fee and credit fee.

- Application Period: June 1-June 30, 2022
- Requirements:
 - *NTHU Admission application number
 - *CV
 - *Lecturer Certificate (English version)

- Successful applicants will be notified before 31st August, 2022 via email.)

STUDENTS MAY NOT APPLY IF THEY

• Hold Taiwan (R.O.C.) nationality or have the status of an overseas Chinese student.

- Are enrolled or have retained admission in a university in Taiwan. (This restriction does not apply to students who are on course to graduate and will be pursuing their next degree; however, they must still be a lecturer from a South or Southeast Asian country.)
- Previously studied in Taiwan for a degree at the same level.
- Are exchange students or dual-degree students through a partnership agreement with an institution overseas.
- Has already received stipends through this program for more than three years.
- Have been awarded by foreign governmental institutions or scholarship from a Taiwan (R.O.C.) government agency to support their studies in Taiwan.

NOTE

• Recipients are NOT allowed to receive NTHU International Student Scholarship during the offered period of this scholarship.
