



2025 Field Trip to Yongkang Incineration Plant

✧ Purpose

The field trip is to deepen exchanges with countries in the New Southbound Policy. Participants will gain and learn about Taiwan's actual experiences in environmental sustainability, green building, energy efficiency, ecological conservation, and related solutions and strategies. By connecting Taiwan's environmental protection field with international talents, this activity will promote mutual exchange and cooperation in environmental protection.

✧ Information

The Yongkang Incineration Plant, located in Tainan City, is a facility dedicated to waste management through incineration and resource recovery. The plant plays a crucial role in the region's waste disposal strategy by converting municipal solid waste into energy while minimizing environmental impact, which is designed to process waste efficiently, reducing the volume of garbage sent to landfills and generating electricity from the incineration process. These approaches not only help in managing waste effectively but also contribute to sustainable energy production.

✧ Event

In this field trip, a lecturer(s) will provide in-depth explanations of Waste-to-Energy technologies for solid waste. Participants will also watch informative videos and visit the incineration plant on-site. In the end, a small-scale discussion will be held for participants to ask questions and exchange opinions on the Waste-to-Energy topic.
