

SCHEDULE 1A SELECTION CRITERIA

The home university must ensure that the student should:

- a. have completed 4 years of undergraduate study
- b. be a student of good standing at the home university and meet the academic requirements of the course of interest at Trinity College Dublin (requirements differ according to the course of relevance)
- c. display a suitable level of competence in English. English is the language of instruction at Trinity College Dublin. Applicants for any postgraduate course of study, whose first language is not English, should include an original or certified true copy of **one** of the following:

IELTS Academic Version	6.5 with no individual band below 6
Cambridge Proficiency in English (CPE)	Grade C
Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)	Grade A
Pearson Test of English (Academic)	PTE Academic: a minimum score of 63 (with no section score below 59)
TOEFL	Paper based 570 with a TWE (test of written English) score of 4.5 Computer based 233 with a score of 4.5 in the essay Internet based 90 with a written score of 21

- e. show the aptitude, motivation and maturity to thrive in the environment at the host university; and
- f. have sufficient funds for all fees, personal and living expenses for the duration of the study abroad at the host university.
